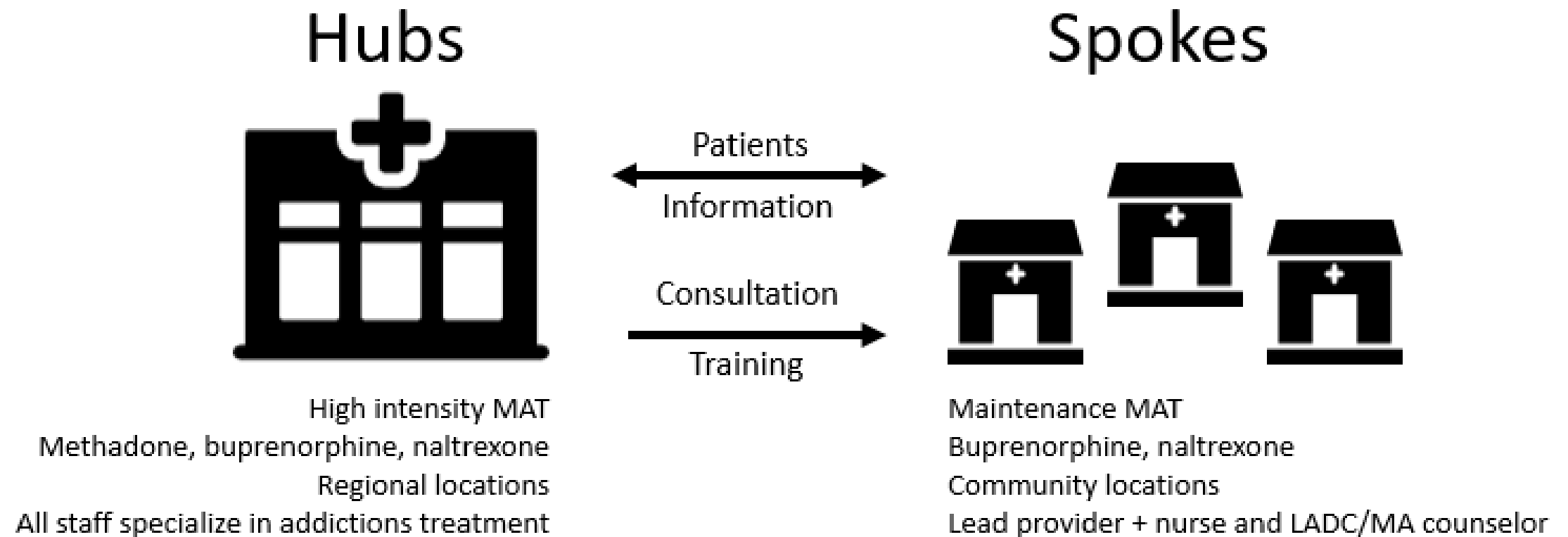

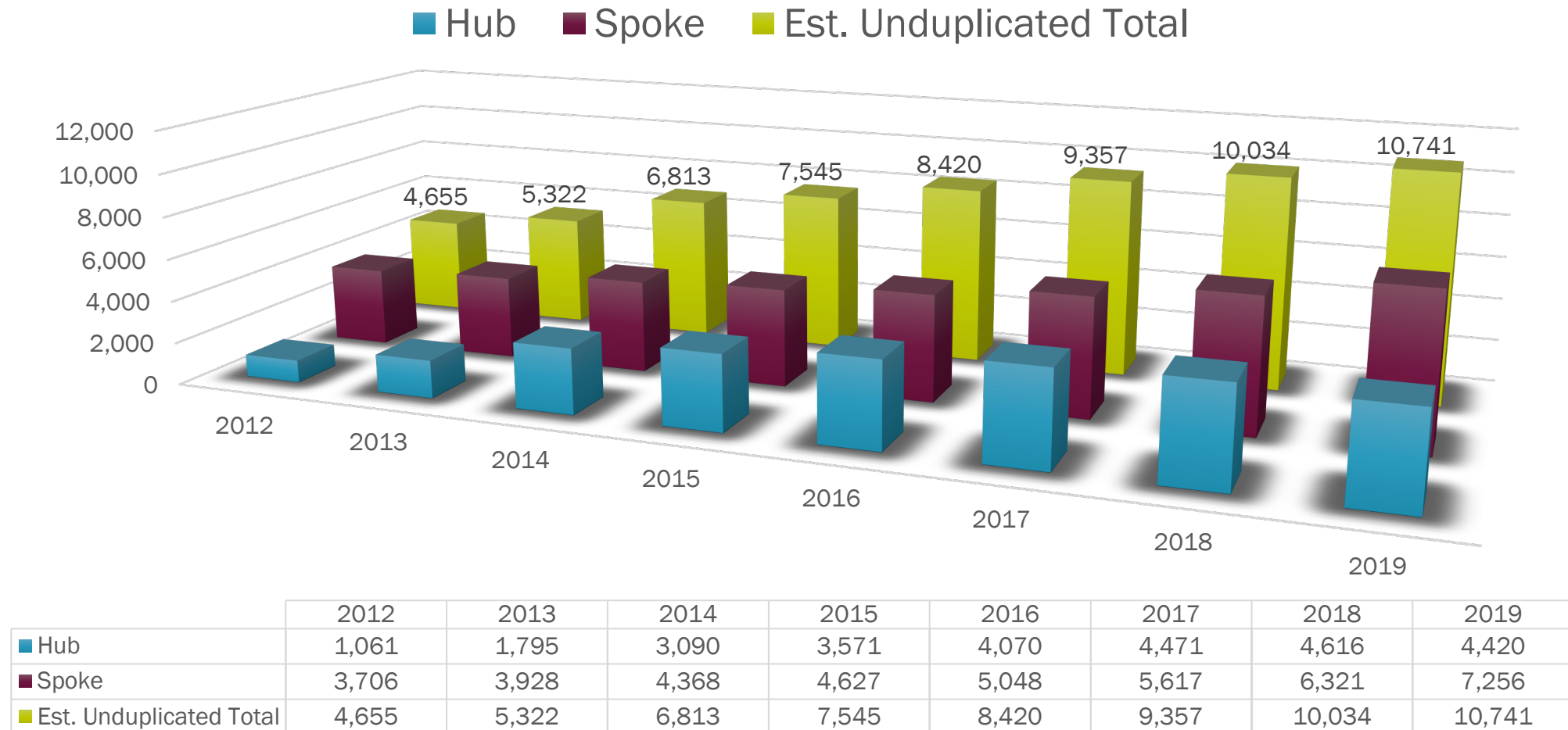
# Medication Assisted Treatment in Vermont: Hub & Spoke System of Care

Hub and Spoke is Vermont's system of Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT), supporting people in recovery from opioid use disorder. Federal regulations designate two settings where MAT can take place: Opioid Treatment Programs (OTPs) and Office Based Opioid Treatment (OBOT) settings. Regional Hubs (OTPs) offer daily support for patients with complex addictions. At Spokes (OBOTs), doctors, nurses, and counselors offer ongoing opioid use disorder treatment fully integrated with general healthcare and wellness services. This framework efficiently deploys opioid use disorder expertise and helps expand access to opioid use disorder treatment for Vermonters.

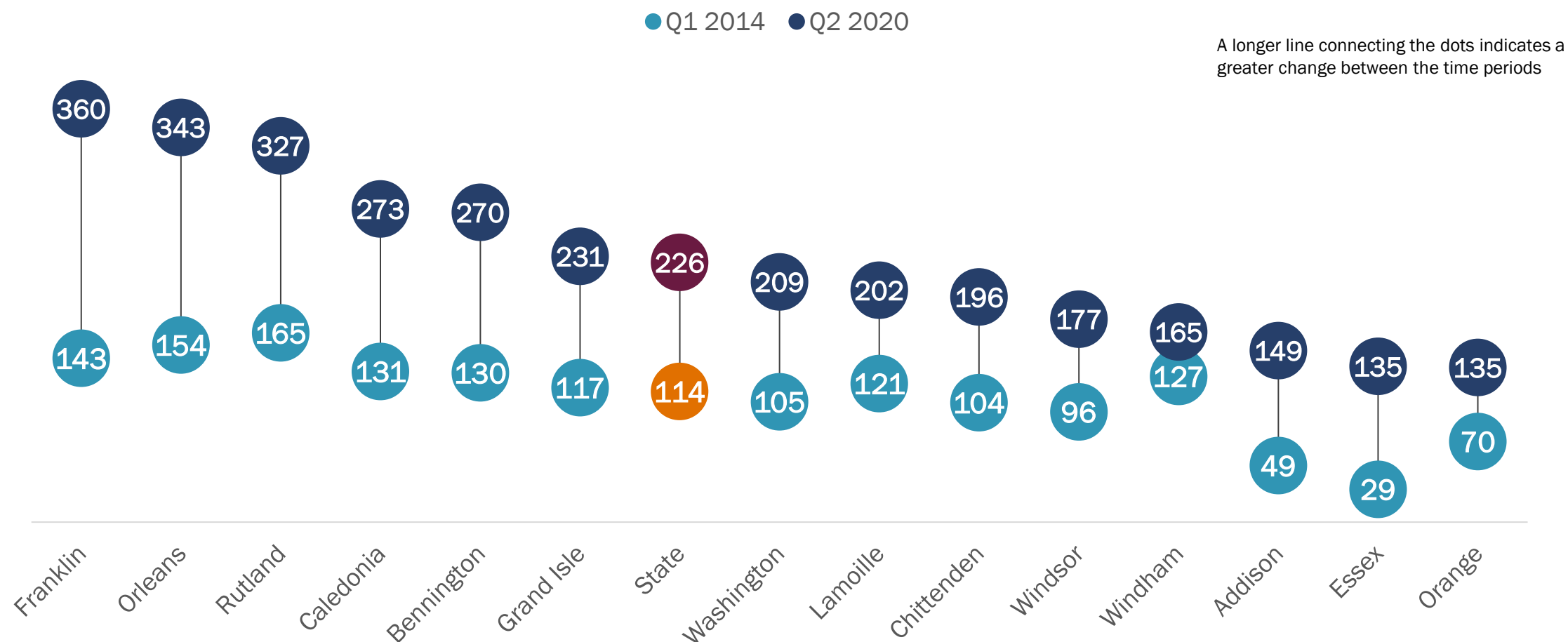

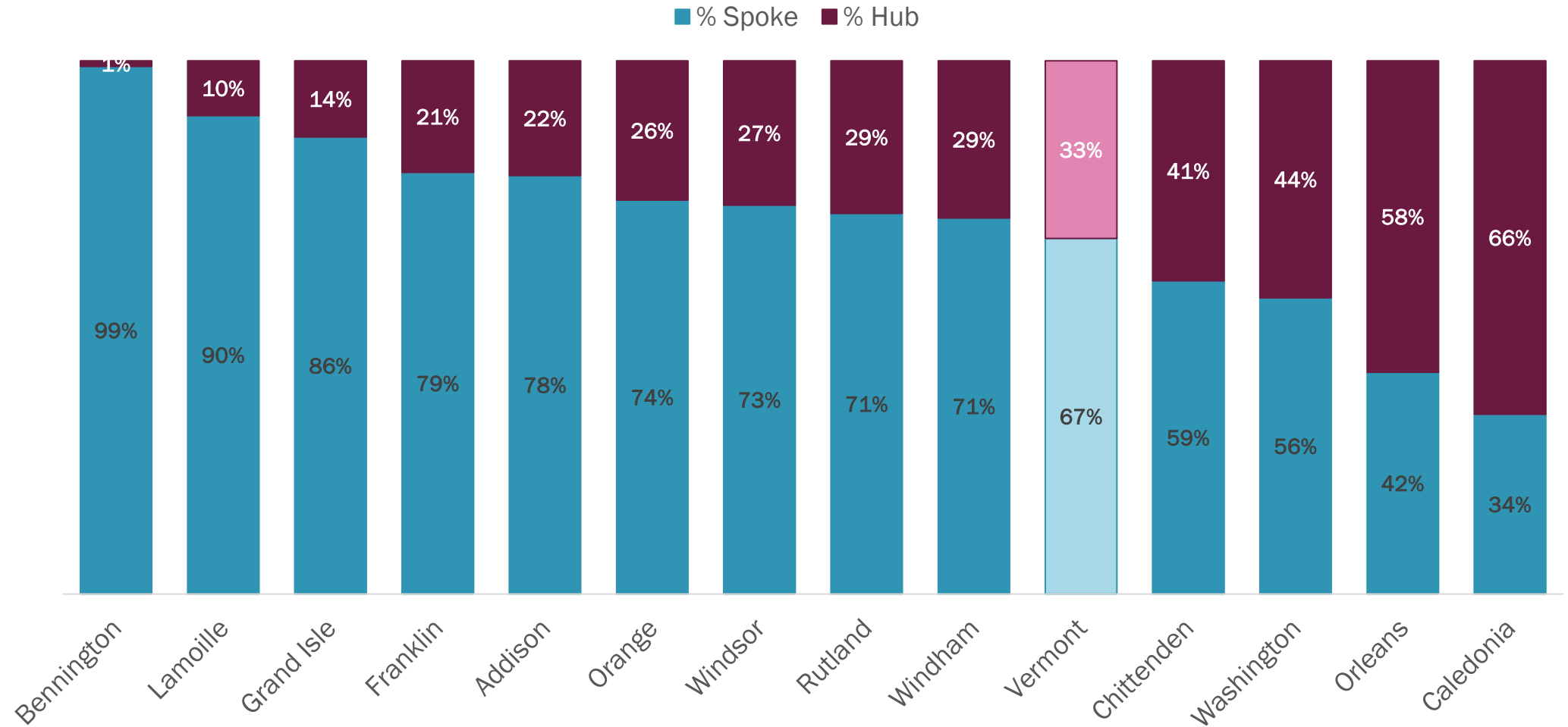
# People Age 18-64 receiving medication assisted treatment for opioid use disorder by year



# Change in MAT for OUD per 10,000 people age 18-64 by county of residence between Q1 2014 to the most recent quarter

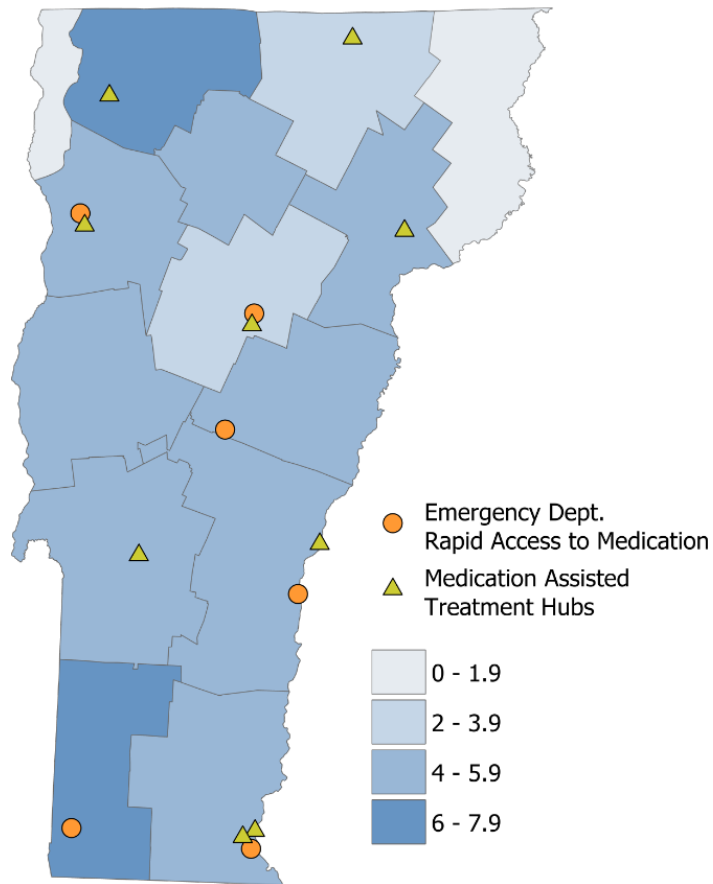


# Percent of people age 18-64 receiving MAT for OUD in hubs vs spokes by county of residence for Q2 2020
